The Story

A Sanctuary During Segregation

Gulfside Assembly was founded in 1923 by Bishop Robert Elijah Jones, the first African American Bishop of the Methodist Episcopal Church.

Gulfside became a beacon of hope during America's darkest era of racial segregation.

When African Americans were denied access to beaches, recreation, and safe gathering spaces, Gulfside offered 600 acres on Mississippi's Gulf Coast where people could experience spiritual renewal, pursue education, organize civil rights dialogues, and swim in the waters of the Gulf of Mexico, a freedom denied elsewhere.



Attorney Constance Baker Motley based her legal work at Gulfside during the historic James Meredith desegregation case.

For generations, Gulfside was where racial and social injustice was confronted, where community was built, and where hope was renewed.

The Legacy Lives On

Gulfside Today

Despite having 13 of its buildings destroyed, Gulfside survived Hurricane Katrina and continues its century-long mission today. Gulfside serves as a 'Partner in Advocacy' to underserved and marginalized communities.

Current Programs & Impact

- **Youth Leadership Programs** - Life skills training, college tours, school uniform distribution, and mentorship
- **Family Programs** - Community garden, resource navigation, child safety programs
- **Community Services** - Health & resource fairs, food drives, emergency preparedness, community events including art, history, and reconciliation programs
- **Senior Programs & Advocacy** - Senior lunch & learn series, support services, social justice initiatives
